

- The watch's built-in full automatic calendar automatically makes allowances for
- The watch's buildent build without calendar automatically makes antowardes for different month lengths and leap years. Once you set the date, there should be no reason to change it except after you have the watch's battery replaced.
 With the 12-hour format, the **PM** indicator appears for times in the range of noon to 11:59 p.m. and no indicator appears for times in the range of midnight to 11:59 a.m.
- With the 24-hour format, times are displayed in the range of 0:00 to 23:59, with
- With the 24-hour tornal, whiles are displayed in the range of 0.00 to 23.59, with the 24H indicator.
 The 12-hour/24-hour timekeeping format you select in the Timekeeping Mode is applied in all other modes.

The backlight uses an LED (light-emitting diode) and a light guide panel that cause the entire display to glow for easy reading in the dark. In any mode, press (B) to illuminate the display for about two seconds. • The illumination provided by the backlight may be hard to see when viewed under

The backlight automatically stops illuminating whenever an alarm sounds.
 Frequent use of the backlight shortens the battery life.

The alarm type is determined by the settings you make, as described below

Set the hour and minutes for the alarm time. This type of setting causes the alarm to

Set the month, day, hour and minutes for the alarm time. This type of setting causes the alarm to sound at the specific time, on the specific date you set.

• 1-Month alarm Set the month, hour and minutes for the alarm time. This type of setting causes the alarm to sound everyday at the time you set, only during the month you set.

Backlight

When you switch the backlight function on, the backlight of the watch flashes whenever Alarm, Hourly Time Signal or Countdown Timer is sounding. Pressing (at any time illuminates the display, regardless of the backlight's on/off setting.

To switch the backlight function on and off



In the Timekeeping Mode, hold down (1) for about two seconds to switch the backlight function on and off. When you switch the backlight function on, an indicator appears on the display as shown.

 The backlight function on indicator remains on the display in all modes until you switch the backlight function off.

The above operation controls operation of the backlight function only. It does not affect operation of audible tones and signals.

Alarm



The multi-function alarm lets you specify the hour, minutes, month, and day for the alarm (page E-14). When the alarm is on, the alarm sounds for 20 seconds at the preset time. When the Hourly Time Signal is on, the watch beeps every hour on the hour. • The alarm and the Hourly Time Signal sound in all modes






The alarm on indicator and the Hourly Time Signal on indicator are shown on the display in all modes while these functions are turned on.

The countdown timer can be set within a range of 1 second to 24 hours. When the countdown reaches zero, an alarm sounds for 10 seconds or until you press any button. . You can also select auto-repeat, which automatically restarts the countdown from the original value you set

Whenever zero is reached. Countdown timer functions are available in the Countdown Timer Mode, which you enter by pressing © (page E-7).

To use the countdown timer

- Press (D) while in the Countdown Timer Mode to start the countdown timer.
- When the end of the countdown is reached and auto-repeat is turned off, the alarm sounds for 10 seconds or until you stop it by pressing any button. The countdown time is automatically reset to its starting value after the alarm stops.
- Press (D) while a countdown operation is in progress to pause it. Press (D) again to resume the countdown.
- To completely stop a countdown operation, first pause it (by pressing ()), and then press (). This returns the countdown time to its starting value.



- In the Countdown Timer Mode, press (A). The hours digits of the countdown start time will start to flash, which indicates the setting screen.
- - . When the end of the countdown is reached while autorepeat is on, the alarm sounds, but the coundown restarts from the beginning without stopping. You can stop the countdown by pressing () and manually reset to the start time by pressing ().
 - The auto-repeat indicator appears in the Countdown Timer Mode only.

The stopwatch lets you measure elapsed time, split times, and two finishes. The range of the stopwatch is 23 hours, 59 minutes, 59 seconds. For the first 60 minutes, the display shows minutes, seconds, and 1/100 second. After 60 minutes, the

display format changes to show hours, minutes, and seconds

All of the operations in this section are performed in the Stopwatch Mode, which you enter by pressing © (page E-7).

This section contains more detailed and technical information about watch operation. It also contains important precautions and notes about the various features and functions of this watch.

Auto return features

Auto return returns If you leave a screen with flashing digits for two or three minutes without performing any operation, the watch automatically saves any settings you have made up to that point and exits the setting screen.

Data and Setting Scrolling The D button is used to scroll through setting screen data on the display. Holding down this button during a scroll operation scrolls through the data at high speed.
